5. ASHWORTH TROPHY. Presented by F.J. Ashworth. First played for in 1909

Open to 1st Division Monthly Medal players. Held by the player returning the best 5 Nett scores (aggregate) for year ending on October Medal Day. Players contest the division in which they play their first medal of the year.

6. CLIFTON TROPHY. Presented by A.B. Frost. First played for in 1929

Open to 2nd Division Monthly Medal players. Conditions same as Ashworth Trophy.

7. BUTLER TROPHY. Presented by E.T. Butler. First Played for in 1986

Open to 3rd Division Monthly Medal players. Conditions same as Ashworth.

8. WILLOWS CUP. Presented by J. Edmund Berry. First played for in 1908

Qualifying round on April Medal Day. First 32 qualify for knockout match play. Maximum Men HI 17 CH 20 Ladies 25.9 CH 30

9. QUEENS CUP. Presented by Dr. J.W.P. Morgan, R.L. Morgan, and A.T. May. First played for in 1953 to commemorate the Coronation of Queen Elizabeth 11 on 2nd June 1953
