Golfers should wear recognised golf clothing of the type sold in quality golf shops.

In and Around the Clubhouse

Smart, casual wear is requested in all public areas. Appropriate footwear should be worn both on and off the golf course.



We allow

Tailored shorts on the course, patio, and in the clubhouse

Clean golfing shoes and clothing in the bar areas

Smart jeans in designated bar areas only

We do not allow

Headgear in the clubhouse

Tracksuits, t-shirts, cargo or combat trousers, rugby or football shirts

Changing clothing in the car park

Wet/muddy clothing or shoes in any bar area

We ask that

Shirts are tucked in unless designed to be worn outside

Short socks worn with shorts are predominantly white or match the shoe colour

Changing rooms are used for changing shoes and clothing

Changing Facilities

Visitors are welcome to use our locker rooms in the clubhouse.

Men's changing facilities are located on the Right hand Side of the clubhouse Ladies' on the Car park side of the clubhouse. Entry codes can be obtained from the Pro Shop, and the Clubhouse.

Mobile Phones

Please use mobile phones discreetly so as not to disturb others. Calls should be made or taken in the car park.



Before you Play

Arrival & Check-in

Please arrive in good time for your tee time. On arrival, check in at the Pro Shop and pay any outstanding green fees.

Be at the 1st tee at least 10 minutes before your start time.

Car Parking

Car parking is available on site and in the overflow car park which is the advisable car park for visiting golf societies and is located 400 yds on Meadow lane on the left hand side.

Buggies & Trolleys

Buggies are available for members and visitors,

Bookable in advance with the Professional shop.

Pull trolleys available for hire from the Professional Shop.

Practice Facilities

Putting Green: Located outside of the clubhouse and for putting/chipping only.

Practice Nets: Located by the Professional Shop.





On the Course

Etiquette

Arrive at the tee 10 minutes before your tee time.

Watch your playing partners' shots and help look for any lost balls.

Play a provisional ball if your ball may be lost or out of bounds.

Be ready to play your shot as soon as it's your turn.

Keep pace with the group in front — if you lose ground, speed up.

Invite faster groups to play through when appropriate.

Position bags towards the next tee before putting out.

Read greens while others are putting to avoid delays.

Mark scorecards after reaching the next tee, not on the green.

Course Care

Replace all divots and fill sand/seed where provided.

Repair your own and any other pitch marks on greens.

Rake bunkers after use and leave rakes in the bunker with handles out.

Health & Safety

If a golf shot leaves the boundary of the golf course, please report this to the Pro Shop or Golf Office as soon as possible.

There are public footpaths running through the golf course. Please take extra care when playing your shots, as members of the public may not be familiar with golf etiquette — especially the meaning of the word “Fore.” Do not hit any shots while a member of the public is within your line of sight.

Priority of Play

18th Green has priority over the 1st Tee.

11th Tee has priority over the 15th Green and 16th Tee.

9th Tee has priority over the 17th Green.

17th Tee has priority over the 16th Green.
