Monday and Tuesday finish Hollow Tines of the Tees, Top Dress and feed Tees. Mow Greens.

Wednesday work on the Greens begins, Poa Buster and cut the Greens.

Thursday Contractors will be on the course to Hollow Tine the Greens and also the Collars and Aprons. They will also remove all Cores. The Staff will follow the Contractors Top Dressing and feeding the Greens.

Holes will be closed as and when the Contractors and staff are working on any specific hole.

Friday the Greens will be sprayed with Feed and a Chelated Iron and Fungicide mix. To promote growth and strength of the grass.

Elsewhere on the course the winter has gone well, the last week has been challenging with hole closures, but hopefully this can now be put behind us. The challenging Winter Program has gone well, The Bunkers have been renewed/renovated and are ready to put into play by the end of the month. The Hedgerow behind 18 has been completed and the Hedgerow behind 2 is almost finished. The Trees that have needed to be taken out have almost been completed, just a little tidying up here and there along with the remnants of Storm Doris. Stump grinding will take place in the next few weeks.

Re profiling of the Fairways will take place in the next week or so (weather permitting)

My Thanks to Dan and all the Team for their hard work over this period, I believe they have achieved more this winter than they have been asked to do previously. This was an ambitious plan which they have come through admirably. Once again thank you to all of them.
